## Pine Bluff Overlook Guidelines For A.R.C. Approval

Any fence, deck, structure, driveway, swimming pool, mailbox, antenna, light pole or fixture, landscaping or exterior modification to the original construction on any lot must receive written approval from the Architectural Review Committee ("ARC") prior to construction. This includes changes in color.

## This is our interpretation of the Covenants and By Laws.

- No Exterior Construction such as Storage Shed, Barn, Large Animal Shelter
- Fence size No higher than 6 Foot. Location cannot proceed in front of home normally aligned with back of home. Material – Wood or Vinyl
- If stained, semi-transparent stain must be used and color needs to blends with community and house.
- Only Standard Mailbox/Post Style and Color are approved
- Front yard must contain at least 2 trees.
- Siding must be wood, wood by product or fiber cement. Aluminum, vinyl or masonite siding are prohibited.
- Driveway must be concrete.
- Swing Sets should be primarily wood construction
- Shingles must be color Weatherwood or its equal
- Paint Main Color and Brick should be neutral that blends with community
- Paint Trim and Shutters needs to be visually appealing
- Gutters should match trim or main color
- No above ground pools
- In ground pools must be approved and not infringe on neighbors use of their yards
- No concrete slab larger than 250 Square Feet and slab must be adjacent to the house
- Portable Gorilla-style basketball goals are allowed but may not be permanently placed in common areas, over streets, sidewalks, or on cul-de-sacs.
- Landscaping cannot be placed on corner lots within a 12'6" X 12'6" X 25' triangle this prevents creating blind spots for motorists.
- Building Height cannot exceed 35 feet
- All outside antennas and satellite dishes are not permitted unless specifically approved by the ARC. Satellite
  dishes of 18" in diameter and less will be approved but ARC consideration will be given as to location, color, and
  other aesthetic considerations.
- Structures including fences must be at least 26 inches apart from each other. With neighbor permission a new fence may be tied to an existing one.
